

**Title: The Joshua Plan - Joshua 1:1-9**

**Read:**

<sup>1-9</sup> After the death of Moses the servant of God, God spoke to Joshua, Moses' assistant: "Moses my servant is dead. Get going. Cross this Jordan River, you and all the people. Cross to the country I'm giving to the People of Israel. I'm giving you every square inch of the land you set your foot on—just as I promised Moses. From the wilderness and this Lebanon east to the Great River, the Euphrates River—all the Hittite country—and then west to the Great Sea. It's all yours. All your life, no one will be able to hold out against you. In the same way I was with Moses, I'll be with you. I won't give up on you; I won't leave you. Strength! Courage! You are going to lead this people to inherit the land that I promised to give their ancestors. Give it everything you have, heart and soul. Make sure you carry out The Revelation that Moses commanded you, every bit of it. Don't get off track, either left or right, so as to make sure you get to where you're going. And don't for a minute let this Book of The Revelation be out of mind. Ponder and meditate on it day and night, making sure you practice everything written in it. Then you'll get where you're going; then you'll succeed. Haven't I commanded you? Strength! Courage! Don't be timid; don't get discouraged. God, your God, is with you every step you take."

**Think:**

Well if Joshua was feeling a bit fed up after his leader Moses had died, then he soon got a quick wake up. No messing here, no lets give him time to grieve. No, God is straight in there. He's reminding Joshua there is a plan and he had better get on with it. And why not after all, Joshua had all he needed and so do we. Because we must remember that God not only had a plan for Joshua but he has a plan for us. And not only does he have a plan for us but he has given us all we need to get on with it. And after all, if God is for us, who can be against us. We too can use the Three D Joshua plan, to achieve our God given goals in life. The first D is Distraction. Joshua is told by God concentrate don't get distracted from the goal you have been given by God. The second D is Devotionals. Joshua is told to spend time reading the Bible. Spend time on your Devotionals, just like you are now. Finally the third D is Do It. Way before Nike told us to "Just Do It", God told Joshua to just get on and do it. So Gods three D plan for Joshua and more importantly for you is don't get DISTRACTED, spend time in the Bible with your DEVOTIONALS and just DO it. Because remember if God is for you who can be against you? You were born to succeed in what God has planned for you.
